

HAIR AND MAKEUP:

Level 1 and Up

MAKEUP:

Stage Makeup is all about enhancing features that get washed out under harsh stage lights!

Dancers should wear:

- Foundation
- Pink Blush
- [Neutral Eyeshadow](#) (we like this palette in “Cream & Sugar”, but you can use what you have on hand)
- Black Eyeliner
- Black Mascara
- [Bright Red Lipstick, shade “Dancer”](#) (**notes below)
- [Tinted Brow Gel](#) (dancers with dark eyebrows may not need this, but it will help our blondes!)

Junior Line + Senior Line + Teen: Add Ardell 105 eyelashes for recital

**The Maybelline Super Stay Matte Lip Color in “Dancer” is a great true red that stays put between dances, but it does have an interesting formula. We suggest you paint it on each lip without rubbing lips together. Keep lips parted for a few minutes to let the longwear lipstick set. A red lip liner may help you achieve clean lines, especially on little lips!

HAIR:

Hair should be parted in the center, pulled back into a low ponytail at the nape of the neck, and secured with an elastic matching the dancer’s hair color. If you’re comfortable using heat tools on your dancer’s hair, please straighten the ponytail for a polished look. Gel and hairspray will be your best friend for taming those baby hairs and keeping hair slicked back all day!

Headpieces should be attached on the *dancer’s right side* just above the ponytail.

*If you’re not sure what to do with a headpiece or accessory, don’t worry, your teacher will be there to help during Picture Week when we all have the costume on together for the first time!
