

Male Dancers, All Ages

HAIR:

We suggest using a strong-hold gel and/or hairspray to hold hair in place. We want your dancer to look polished on stage, and not be tempted to touch his hair in the middle of their routine.

MAKEUP:

We use makeup on stage to help define features that get blown out under harsh stage lighting. It's not required, but dancers may choose to wear foundation, bronzer/contour underneath the cheekbones and jawline, and/or mascara. The decision to wear makeup or go with a bare face is up to each dancer and their parents.

SOCKS + SHOES:

Black ballet shoes and black tap shoes from Bobby's Dancewear should be worn for our Picture Day and Rehearsal/Recital events. Dancers should wear thin black dress socks under shoes.

To avoid dancers being distracted by their shoes coming untied, we suggest tying the elastic string in a bow and using duct tape to tape the strings inside on the top of the shoe! And please don't forget to write your dancer's name inside all of your items in case they get mixed up backstage.

A Note for Recital Week:

Male dancers over age 5 will not be allowed in the main dressing room. These dancers should be accompanied backstage by a parent who will work with the class StageMom to coordinate costume changes, and call times.
